| • August 1, 2004 | Notification of abstract acceptance |
| • November 1, 2004 | Full-length manuscript due |
| • December 20, 2004 | Notification of full-length manuscript acceptance |
| • February 1, 2005 | Camera-ready manuscripts and pre-registration of at least one of the co-authors with registration fee due |

All full-length manuscripts will be peer reviewed. All accepted papers will be published in the Conference Proceedings that will be available at the Conference site. Also the papers of JSME members will be endorsed for publication in the JSME International Journal upon reviewers' recommendation.
