"Otaru Kihinkan" is located in northwest of downtown. In the site of this restaurant, an old antique house "Old Aoyama Villa" is preserved. This house was built in around 1920, by Aoyama family who succeeded in herring fishery. Many rooms of this house are architectures of traditional Japanese style.
