Flowchart for Presenting Authors attending on-site 1/3

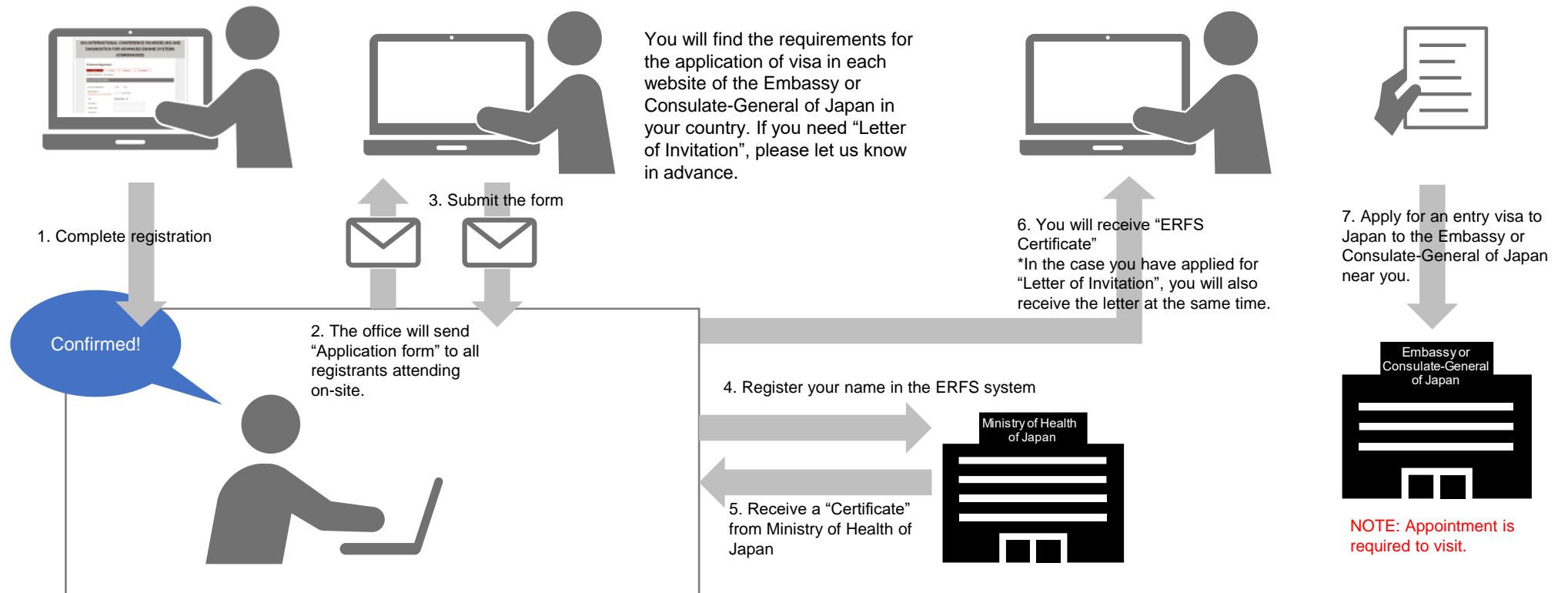

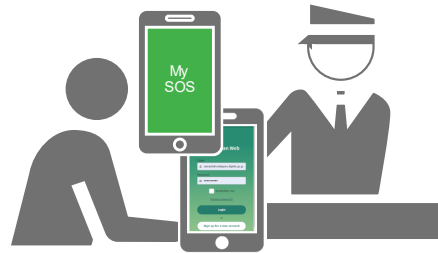
We recommend you completing these procedure **one day before** your departure at latest.

You **MUST** check the Border measures of your country for returning to your country.

Arrival in Japan: Immigration and later



Author (Presenter) *attending on-site



This process (just showing the green screen at the immigration) covers steps below.

1. Inspection Certificate (within 72 hours of departure)
2. Written Pledge (If you are required to stay at facility designated by the Quarantine Station)
3. QR code from Questionnaire



If you are tested **NEGATIVE**, go to "STEP 10".

If you are tested **POSITIVE**, you will need to follow directions of the Chief of the Quarantine Station and recuperate at a specific facility designated by the Chief of the Quarantine Station. In this situation, the quarantine period cannot be shortened.



**Please entry Japan with plenty of time!
It might take around 2 to 5 hours for STEP 8 and 9,
but it might take more time depending on a crowded situation.**
