




- 1. Inspection Certificate (within 72 hours of departure)
- 2. Written Pledge (If you are required to stay at facility designated by the Quarantine Station)
- 3. OR code from Questionnaire



If you are tested NEGATIVE, go to "STEP 10".

If you are tested POSITIVE, you will need to follow directions of the Chief of the Quarantine Station and recuperate at a specific facility designated by the Chief of the Quarantine Station. In this situation, the quarantine period cannot be shortened.
